





Crystal Hair Band

Step 1 - Start by threading 71 crystal cubes onto your nylon thread. You need about 2 metres of thread - secure at 1 end of the nylon with a temporary knot.



Step 2 - Now tie the un-knotted end of your nylon thread to the end of the hair band, leaving a 2cm gap from the end. Trim excess nylon and dab a bit of glue to the knot ensuring the glue attaches the nylon thread to the inside edge of the metal hair band.



Step 3 - Hold the hair band in front of you. From the outside edge, bring the string of cubes over the top surface of the hair band, placing a cube from the nylon thread onto the surface of the band - It should sit at an angle on the band. Then take your nylon thread around on the inside of the hair band and pull tight to hold the cube in place.



Step 4 - Again, from the outside edge, lift a cube onto the surface of the hair band, placing neatly next to the 1st cube. Take the nylon thread around on the inside of the band.

Step 5 - Repeat this process all the way around the hair band, making sure you sit each cube neatly next to the previous one.

Step 6 - When you get to the other end of your band you should be approx 2cm from the end. If you are not, gently slid the cubes along the band, so the last cube is 2cm from the end. Wrap your nylon around the hair band a few times and knot securely. Dab a small amount of glue onto the knot as you did at the beginning.



Step 7 - To neaten ends, take a small piece of ribbon approx 2cm long and wrap this around the end of the hair band, attaching with some glue. Take your time to get a neat finish. Repeat on the other side. As an alternative, the hair band ends can be wrapped with thread or cord to give a neat finish.

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
