Your housing community project might be the biggest investment of your time, energy, and money that you will make date. What you create could positively influence the ecological, social, cultural and economic aspects of the whole area. And what you put into form, on land, will last for generations. So, considering all that's on the line, starting with a solid foundation of skills, knowledge, networks, and processes will go a long way to ensure that future time, energy and money for the project is well spent and where savings could be harnessed through regenerative design and partnerships.

This Accelerator and Mastermind programme is an investment in yourself as a project creator and lead, in the team you have or will be creating, in your community impact, and is the foundation investment in your project.

The best investment you could make for your project would be in building that regenerative foundation from which all savings and positive future investment could flow. And the best investment would be in yourself and your working team, to give you the knowledge, resources, and connections to lead, manage and bring to life the best possible project results.

It is estimated you will invest a minimum of 3-4 hours a week towards your own and others' progress but the more you commit, the more you progress on your project.

WHAT YOU GET WITH THIS SIX-MONTH PROGRAMME:



6 x 2 hour in-depth Accelerator workshops (approximately one per month) with an expert in the field of regenerative place-making, intentional community, or housing development, tailored to participants interests and needs, to give you the insight and clarity on any stage of your project. You will receive relevant handouts, assignments, and guides for each presentation



6 x 1.5 hour workshops on regenerative design and processes to guide your project's direction and deepen and expand the quality of your thinking and working plus assignments to apply this to your project



6 x 1.5 hour facilitated Mastermind discussions on curated topics and themes related to developing a community-led, affordable, sustainable collective housing project. This is where you will also learn from each other's experiences and have access to each other's insights.



Hot Seat Mastermind sessions: Each participant will have a hot seat "collective wisdom" session to bring a challenge or big question about their project or idea to the group to gain from the group's experience and perspective.



An accountability structure and partner matched



Year access to the membership forum platform for communicating with programme lead and programme participants, posting and reading news and information, sharing ideas.



A 5-day challenge related to your learning and project goals, designed to be fun while gaining significant traction and setting new thinking and behaviour patterns.
